PUBLIC USE OF CARP (COUDERSPORT AREA RECREATION PARK) TRACK

The Coudersport Area School District welcomes community members who wish to walk or run on the track for exercise at CARP. The track will be open *Monday through Friday (except holidays)* from *8:00AM to 9:00PM* during the months of *June through September* and will be closed during *school-sponsored activities*. We request that you be respectful of your property and be responsible in following the guidelines listed below:

1. All participants must secure a CARP Track usage identification badge prior to using the facility. You can obtain this badge at the High School main office.
2. All participants must remain on the track area at all times. Please refrain from walking on the grass and the bleacher areas.
3. Participants must wear appropriate footwear (walking shoes, tennis shoes, etc.). No spikes of any kind are permitted.
4. Participants must be 18 years of age or older. Children are permitted to use the track if accompanied by an adult. Students in Jr-Sr High School can receive a waiver to use the track from the high school principal when warranted.
5. Please dispose of all water bottles or garbage in the appropriate containers located at the entrance gate area.
6. No pets.
7. No bicycles.
8. Please help us enforce proper use of this facility. Report any observed vandalism or inappropriate usage of the track to Mr. Steve Gerner (814-274-9015).
9. Participants not abiding by the above guidelines will be prohibited from using the track.
